WOW Sermon Series – How We Worship

Through May 12th, the Worship on Wednesday (WOW) worshipers are listening in as Village Presbyterian Church in Prairie Village, Kansas explores worship. Like us, they are a busy church. Like us, they do many things across their ministries: mission, education, fellowship, care giving. But the one thing the church universal does that sets it apart from all other groups and organizations is worship the Living God. Different churches worship God in different ways. In this sermon series, we join in as they explore the different elements of worship. From the call to worship to the confession of sin to hymns and sacraments, the series explains how and why we, the Presbyterian church, worship the way we do. Will You Buy a Pair of Shoes?
